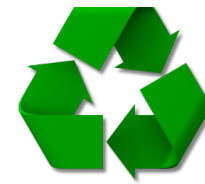

What to Recycle

P – PAPER /CARDBOARD/CHIPBOARD /
JUNK MAIL (TIE WITH STRING OR PLACE IN
STURDY CONTAINER)


1. NEWSPAPER
2. MAGAZINES, MIXED OFFICE PAPER,
PHONE BOOKS/SOFT COVERED
BOOKS
3. CARDBOARD (CORRUGATED BOXES)
4. CHIPBOARD – FROZEN FOOD BOXES/
BEER & SODA BOXES/CEREAL
BOXES/GIFT BOXES, etc...



R – RECYCLING – WE COLLECT: GLASS
BOTTLES/ALUMINUM AND TIN CANS/EMPTY
AEROSOL CANS AND PLASTIC BOTTLES AND
JUGS/PAPER MILK AND JUICE CARTONS

***REMOVE TOPS AND LIDS PRIOR TO
RECYCLING**

****RINSE OUT RECYCLING BEFORE SETTING
IT OUT!**

NOTE: Accepted plastic items will be numbered
1-6 in the universally recognized recycling
triangle () located on the bottom of the item.

All items can be mixed together and placed in a
sturdy 32 gallon container marked with a Linden
recycling label. **THEY WILL NEVER BE
COLLECTED IN PLASTIC BAGS!**

G – GRASS CLIPPINGS – NO YARD WASTE

B – BAGGED LEAVES – NO YARD WASTE



Where & How to Recycle

Curbside on **P-PAPER** day
or Drop-off @ Recycling
Center

Tie securely with string or twine only.
**CURBSIDE PAPER WILL NOT BE
COLLECTED IN PLASTIC BAGS!**

RECYCLE – IT'S THE LAW!




Curbside on **R-RECYCLING**
day or Drop-off @ Recycling
Center

Comingle (mix) in sturdy bucket.
**CURBSIDE RECYCLING
WILL NOT BE COLLECTED IN
PLASTIC BAGS!**

Curbside or Drop-off @
Recycling Center*



When placed at the curb, grass and
bagged leaves may be placed in
biodegradable paper bags or in open
cans- they will **NOT** be accepted in
plastic bags. Do **NOT** mix in yard
waste or other vegetation.

METALS:

WHITE GOODS- Washers, Dryers, Stoves, Ranges, Refrigerators, Aluminum, Brass, Copper

ELECTRONIC DEVICES

(E-WASTE)

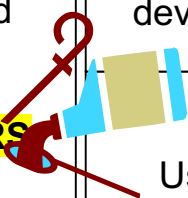
Electronic devices covered are T.V.'s, Monitors, Computers, and Laptops **(ONLY) !**

USED MOTOR OIL/OIL FILTERS & COOKING OIL

UNBROKEN FLUORSCENT TUBES (NO CFLs)

USED CLOTHING/ TEXTILES

Includes paired shoes and socks, hats, belts, drapes, towels, sheets, nylon curtains. (Can also be saved for charitable drives.)



Where & How to Recycle

When brought to the Recycling Center, electronic devices should be placed in the **Electronics Trailer**.

Recycling Center ONLY

Used motor and cooking oil can be brought to the Recycling Center to be properly recycled in their containers. **RESIDENTS only with ID**, no more than **5 GALLONS**. **NO OTHER CAR OR PAINT PRODUCTS ACCEPTED.**

Unbroken Fluorescent Tubes are now accepted at the recycling center.

NO CFL'S (Compact Fluorescent Lamps)

Recycling Center ONLY

All clothing and textile items should be placed in the **CLOTHING BIN**.

Non-recyclable items...

- Window glass/Ceramics/Mirrors/Crystal/Dishes/Drinking glasses/Pyrex/Light bulbs
- Wet clothing/Pillows/Rugs/Foam-backed drapes
- Aerosol cans and paint cans that are not completely empty!
- Any container from pesticides, gasoline, kerosene, propane, etc.
- Plastic flower pots/5 gallon buckets/Styrofoam
- Plastic and metal lids/Caps from bottles & jars
- Containers with **FOOD LEFT INSIDE** /Garden hoses

NOT ACCEPTED AT RECYCLING CENTER... Paint cans, Branches, Lumber, Construction Debris, Couches, Mattresses, Carpets, etc.

These items should be placed at the curb on your T-Trash day.
