

**NOTICE TO BIDDERS
CITY OF LINDEN
UNION COUNTY, NEW JERSEY**

Sealed bids will be received by the Purchasing Agent of the City of Linden at 301 North Wood Avenue, Plan Room #215, Linden, New Jersey 07036 on April 8, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. prevailing time, and then publicly opened and read aloud for:

**TRANSIT VILLAGE STREETScape (PHASE 3)
CITY OF LINDEN
UNION COUNTY, NEW JERSEY**

The work to be performed under this contract includes the following:
The construction of decorative stamped concrete sidewalk and landscape improvements along Wood Avenue between Pennsylvania Railroad Avenue and Morris Avenue. In addition, the project includes the construction of handicap ramps in conformance with current ADA requirements.

Principal items of work in the project include:

- 1,150 S.Y. Stamped Concrete Sidewalk, 4" Thick
- 340 S.Y. Stamped Concrete Sidewalk, Reinforced, 6" Thick
- 280 S.Y. Stamped Concrete Driveway, 6" Thick

The work contemplated under this Contract shall be completed by August 31, 2015.

Copies of plans, specification, and contract documents will be on file for public inspection and may be obtained upon payment of \$40.00, said sum not refundable, at Linden City Hall, Purchasing Department, Room #202, 301 North Wood Avenue, Linden, New Jersey 07036, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. prevailing time, Monday through Friday, excluding legal holidays.

Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope clearly marked TRANSIT VILLAGE STREETScape (PHASE 3) and bearing the name and address of the bidder on outside; addressed to the Purchasing Agent, City of Linden, City Hall, 301 N. Wood Avenue, Linden, New Jersey 07036. Each bid must be made upon the prescribed forms, furnished with the Contract Drawings and Specifications, including the non-collusion affidavit and ownership statement compliance form and must be accompanied by a Consent of Surety and a certified check or Bid Bond of not less than ten (10%) percent of the amount bid and, not to exceed \$20,000.00. Such checks and Bonds shall be made payable to the City of Linden and will be held as a Guarantee that in the event the Bid is accepted and a Contract awarded to the bidder, the Contract shall be duly executed and its performance properly secured. The successful bidder shall furnish and deliver to the Owner a performance and payment bond in the amount of 100 percent of the accepted bid amount as security for the faithful performance and payment of the Contract. Further, the successful bidder must furnish the policies or Certificates of Insurance required by the Contract. In default thereof, said checks and the amount represented thereby will be forfeited to the aforesaid Owner as liquidated damages. Bids must be accompanied, in the case of corporations not chartered in New Jersey, by proper certificate that such corporation is authorized to do business in the State of New Jersey.

ALL BIDDERS shall conform to the intention and provisions of Affirmative Action in Public Contract Laws of the State of New Jersey R.S. 10:2-1 of 7/23/75, Assembly Bill No. 2227.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27 regarding equal employment opportunity, as amended. All corporations and partnerships must comply with Chapter 33, of the P.L. of 1977, regarding disclosure of partners and stockholders. Each bid must be enclosed in a sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the bidder, addressed to the Owner and labeled for the TRANSIT VILLAGE STREETSCAPE (PHASE 3).

The successful bidder will be required to comply with all provisions of prevailing wage rates as determined by the New Jersey Department of Labor.

All bids shall be irrevocable, not subject to withdrawal and shall stand available for a period of sixty (60) days.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive informalities or irregularities in the bids received and to accept the bid from the lowest responsible bidder.
