**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER VII, TRAFFIC, OF AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND ENACTING THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LINDEN, 1999," PASSED NOVEMBER 23, 1999 AND APPROVED NOVEMBER 24, 1999, AND AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LINDEN:**

Section 1. That Chapter VII, Traffic, shall be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

Chapter VII, Traffic

**7-33 HANDICAPPED PARKING REGULATIONS**

**7-33.1A Handicapped Parking On-Street**

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Spaces</u>	<u>No. of Location</u>
<b>ADD:</b> 119 E. Henry Street	1	On the northwesterly sideline of E. Henry Street, 133 feet more or less northeasterly from the projection of the northeasterly curblineline of Moore Place in front of 119 E. Henry Street for a length of 22 feet. The aforesaid space is specifically reserved and designated for a vehicle for June Dolci to be identified by license plate number and a placard to be issued by the City, and no other vehicle bearing or displaying handicapped license plates and/or placards, or not, shall be permitted to park in such space.
20 E. Curtis Street	1	On the southeasterly sideline of E. Curtis Street, 194 feet more or less northeasterly from the projection of the northeasterly curblineline of N. Wood Avenue in front of 20 E. Curtis Street for a length of 22 feet. The aforesaid space is specifically reserved and designated for Robert Kahney to be identified by license plate number and a placard to be issued by the City, and no other vehicle bearing or displaying handicapped license plates and/or placards, or not, shall be permitted to park in such space.
513 Alexander Avenue	1	On the southwesterly sideline of Alexander Avenue, 130 feet more or less northwesterly from the projection of the northwesterly curblineline of Dill Avenue in front of 513 Alexander Avenue for a length of 22 feet. The aforesaid space is specifically reserved and designated for Dennis Wasko to be identified by license plate number and a placard to be issued by the City, and no other vehicle bearing or displaying handicapped license plates and/or placards, or not, shall be permitted to park in such space.

500 W. Blancke Street	1	On the southwesterly sideline of Spruce Street, 74 feet more of less northwesterly from the projection of the northwesterly curblineline of W. Blancke Street on the side of School 8 (500 W. Blancke Street) for a length of 22 feet.
South Wood Avenue (3203 Tremley Point Road)	1	On the southwesterly sideline of S. Wood Avenue, 540 feet more of less southeasterly from the projection of the southeasterly curblineline of Main Street, in the rear of 3203 Tremley Point Road for a length of 22 feet. The aforesaid space is specifically reserved and designated for Marie Pizzi to be identified by license plate number and a placard to be issued by the City, and no other vehicle bearing or displaying handicapped license plates and/or placards, or not, shall be permitted to park in such space.

Section 2. The remaining provisions of the Chapter hereby amended and supplemented shall continue in full force and effect to the same extent as if herein fully repeated.

Section 3. If any section, subsection, provision, clause, or portion of this ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall not affect the remaining sections, subsections, provisions, clauses, or portions, which shall be deemed severable therefrom.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect in the manner provided by law.
