**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER VII,
TRAFFIC, OF AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED, "AN
ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND ENACTING THE REVISED
GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LINDEN, 1999,"
PASSED NOVEMBER 23, 1999 AND APPROVED NOVEMBER
24, 1999, AND AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LINDEN:

Section 1. That Chapter VII, Traffic, Section 7-7.3, Temporary Parking Prohibition for Snow Plowing and Removal, shall be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

7-7.3 Temporary Parking Prohibition for Snow Plowing and Removal.

- a. Whenever the Mayor, Chief of Police or, in his absence, the ranking officer issues a winter storm warning for an area including the City of Linden, which warning includes a forecast of snow, an emergency shall exist and within 6 hours of the issuance of said warning no vehicle shall be parked on the streets or highways or portions thereof indicated.

The above parking prohibitions shall remain in effect for forty-eight hours after the snow has ceased until the streets have been plowed sufficiently and to the extent that parking will not interfere with the normal flow of traffic.

- b. An unoccupied vehicle parked or standing in violation shall be deemed a nuisance and a menace to the safe and proper regulation of traffic and any Police Officer may provide for the removal of such vehicle. The owner shall pay the reasonable costs of the removal and storage which may result from such removal before regaining possession of the vehicle.

- c. It shall be a violation of this section for any unoccupied vehicle, parked or standing, not to be moved forty-eight (48) hours after the snow has ceased or after 6 hours after the issuance of winter storm warning. The fine shall be \$100.00 per day, with each day after said forty-eight (48) hour period to be considered a continuing violation. If deemed a nuisance and a menace to the safe and proper regulation of traffic, any police officer may also provide for the removal of such vehicle(s). The owner shall pay, in addition to any fines, the reasonable costs of the removal and storage which may result from such removal before regaining possession of such vehicle(s).
