AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER VII, TRAFFIC, OF AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND ENACTING THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LINDEN, 1999," PASSED NOVEMBER 23, 1999 AND APPROVED NOVEMBER 24, 1999, AND AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LINDEN:

Section 1. That Chapter VII, Traffic, shall be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

Chapter VII, Traffic

7-33 HANDICAPPED PARKING REGULATIONS

7-33.1A Handicapped Parking On-Street

628 E. Blancke Street	1	On the southeasterly sideline of E. Blancke Street, 156 feet more or less southwesterly from the projection of the southwesterly curblineline of Bower Street in front of 628 E. Blancke Street for a length of 22 feet. The aforesaid space is specifically reserved and designated for a vehicle for Adele Bradner to be identified by license plate number and a placard to be issued by the City, and no other vehicle bearing or displaying handicapped license plates and/or placards, or not, shall be permitted to park in such space.
1119 Dill Avenue	1	On the northwesterly sideline of Dill Avenue, 184 feet more or less northeasterly from the projection of the northeasterly curblineline of E. Baltimore Avenue in front of 1119 Dill Avenue for a length of 22 feet. The aforesaid space is specifically reserved and designated for a vehicle for Charles James to be identified by license plate number and a placard to be issued by the City, and no other vehicle bearing or displaying handicapped license plates and/or placards, or not, shall be permitted to park in such space.

504 Washington Avenue	1	On the northeasterly sideline of Washington Avenue, 47 feet more or less northwesterly from the projection of the northwesterly curbline of E. Elm Street in front of 504 Washington Avenue for a length of 22 feet. The aforesaid space is specifically reserved and designated for a vehicle for Colin MacDonnell to be identified by license plate number and a placard to be issued by the City, and no other vehicle bearing or displaying handicapped license plates and/or placards, or not, shall be permitted to park in such space.
115 W. Eighteenth Street	1	On the southeasterly sideline of W. Eighteenth Street, 185 feet more or less southwesterly from the projection of the southwesterly curbline of Winans Avenue in from of 115 W. Eighteenth Street for a length of 22 feet. The aforesaid space is specifically reserved and designated for a vehicle for Ernestine Evans to be identified by license plate number and a placard to be issued by the City, and no other vehicle bearing or displaying handicapped license plates and/or placards, or not, shall be permitted to park in such space.

Section 2. The remaining provisions of the Chapter hereby amended and supplemented shall continue in full force and effect to the same extent as if herein fully repeated.

Section 3. If any section, subsection, provision, clause, or portion of this ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall not affect the remaining sections, subsections, provisions, clauses, or portions, which shall be deemed severable therefrom.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect in the manner provided by law.
