AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER II, ADMINISTRATION, OF AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND ENACTING THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LINDEN, 1999," PASSED NOVEMBER 23, 1999 AND APPROVED NOVEMBER 24, 1999, AND AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LINDEN:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Administration, Article IV, Department Established, Section 2-12 Department of Police, shall be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

2-12 DEPARTMENT OF POLICE.

2-12.1 Created – Department of Police.

The Department of Police is hereby created pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:14-118 and shall consist of the following positions: (1) Chief; (5) Captains; (12) Lieutenants; (16) Sergeants; (115) Patrol Officers; and civilian personnel as the Council may determine by ordinance. The Department shall be under the day to day supervision and control of the Chief, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:14-118, who shall be appointed by the Mayor.

Section 2. The remaining provisions of the chapter hereby amended and supplemented shall continue in full force and effect to the same extent as if herein fully repeated.

Section 3. If any section, subsection, provision, clause, or portion of this ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall not affect the remaining sections, subsections, provisions, clauses, or portions, which shall be deemed severable therefrom.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect in the manner provided by law.
