

Guide to COLLECTION DAYS & ITEMS

VARIOUS TRUCKS COLLECT THE FOLLOWING ITEMS at DIFFERENT TIMES:

S - SANITATION - HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE. WE WILL NOT COLLECT BULKY ITEMS ON THIS DAY. WE CANNOT ACCEPT RADIOLOGICAL WASTE: CALL THE CITY HEALTH DEPT. @ 908-847-8409 FOR DISPOSAL WE WILL ACCEPT MEDICAL SYRINGES IN A SEALED STURDY CONTAINER CLEARLY LABELED "**NEEDLES**"

R - RECYCLING - WE COLLECT: GLASS BOTTLES / ALUMINUM AND TIN CANS / EMPTY AEROSOL CANS AND PLASTIC BOTTLES AND JUGS. Accepted plastic Items will be labeled R1-R-6 in the universally recognized recycling triangle located on the bottom of the item. All items can be mixed together and placed in a sturdy 32 gallon container marked with a Linden recycling label. **THEY WILL NEVER BE COLLECTED IN PLASTIC BAGS.**

H - HOLIDAY - NO SERVICES ON THESE DAYS
ITEMS PLACED AT THE CURB ON A HOLIDAY MAY RESULT IN A SUMMONS AND FINE.

T - TRASH - BULK WASTE / YARD WASTE / APPLIANCES / FURNITURE / HARDENED - DRIED LATEX PAINT (NO LIDS) / WOOD (*NAILS BENT BACK*) AND METAL PIPES MUST BE CUT INTO 4' LENGTHS / RUGS - ROLLED INTO 4' LENGTHS and TIED / ATTIC CONTENTS / TREE BRANCHES & BRUSH CUT INTO 6' LENGTHS AND PLACED UNIFORMLY AT THE CURB. **TIE BRANCHES / REMOVE ROOTS & DIRT.** DISCONNECT PROPANE TANKS FROM GRILLS. DRAIN FUEL & OIL FROM MOWERS AND BLOWERS. SEPARATE METALS AND KEEP TO ONE SIDE OF TRASH PILE. **WE WILL NOT COLLECT CARDBOARD AS TRASH.** YOU MUST RECYCLE CARDBOARD ON YOUR SCHEDULED PAPER DAY.

WE DO NOT COLLECT:

Asphalt / bricks / blocks / concrete / truck tires / car tires with rims / liquids / chemicals / sealers / dirt / building - construction material.

P - PAPER / CARDBOARD / CHIPBOARD / JUNK MAIL

1. NEWSPAPER AND ALL CONTENTS OF SUNDAY PAPER - Tie w/string
 2. MAGAZINES, FLIERS, ENVELOPES & SCHOOL PAPERS - Tie w/string
 3. CORRUGATED CARDBOARD - Flatten & tie w/string
 4. CHIPBOARD - FROZEN FOOD BOXES / BEER & SODA BOXES / CEREAL BOXES / GIFT BOXES, etc... Flatten & tie w/string
- Paper day items can be placed in a sturdy can labeled with a City of Linden recycling sticker.

G - GRASS - GRASS CLIPPINGS FROM YOUR LAWNMOWER WILL BE ACCEPTED IN BIODEGRADABLE PAPER BAGS OR OPEN CANS Labeled with recycling stickers. **DO NOT MIX IN YARD WASTE OR OTHER VEGETATION & DO NOT PUT GRASS IN PLASTIC BAGS.**

The County of Union provides household hazardous waste disposal days for most items not collected by the Linden Public Works Department. For more information call the Bureau of Environmental Services Hotline at (908) 654-9889.

Accepted items are: Full aerosol cans, antifreeze, batteries, caustics, corrosives & cleaners, fire extinguishers, unbroken fluorescent bulbs, thermostats & mercury switches, motor oil & oil filters, oil based paints - varnishes, pesticides & herbicides, pool maintenance chemicals, gasoline, solvents & thinners.

LEAF SEASON RULES: EFFECTIVE OCTOBER - NOVEMBER - DECEMBER

We do not follow the regular street sweeping schedule during these months. Parking regulations are still enforced by the Police Department
Our machines collect leaves in the curb line on a rotating district basis. Piled leaves raked into curb line must be free of dirt, rocks, sticks, branches, other vegetative waste & garbage debris. Piled leaves must be kept at least 10' from storm runoff basins.

City Trees - It is illegal for residents to cut down or trim any tree on City property. It is also illegal to hang lights / ornaments or surround the base of the tree with landscaping or decorative products. Failure to comply may result in a summons. Graffiti reporting hotline 908-474-0341.
